



Overview for Driver Competency Assessment (DCA2)

- Actual in-car assessment done by our Certified Driver Competency Evaluator (CDCE), who is also a State Certified Driving Instructor (CDI) and a Driver Rehabilitation Specialist (DRS).
- The DCA consists of a 45-60 minute on-road “Assessment”. The Assessment is NOT pass or fail. (See attached information for more details).
- The driver is evaluated on how well they manage the 6 variables which influence a driver’s crash potential versus “the average driver’s risk of a crash” through 12 segments. The results are then sent off to be processed. A report will be generated with a written analysis, along with recommendations. (See attached documents for more details).
- This report is then sent to the requesting party or the client. Either may request a “debriefing”. It is strongly recommended for the client to have a debriefing/explanation of the assessment results.
- The fee for the Driver Competency Assessment is \$275.00
- The Assessment has a specific route that begins and ends at our Office in Bossier City (see address below).
- The Assessment will be done in our State-approved vehicle. Our vehicle is equipped with a passenger side instructor’s brake and gas pedal. We use an unmarked, late model Honda Accord, with an automatic transmission and power seats.
- Remediation may be recommended and is available through First Class. If remedial training is needed, the fee ranges from \$125-\$175/hour which includes use our specially equipped training vehicle. In some cases we may be able to use the clients vehicle for training.
